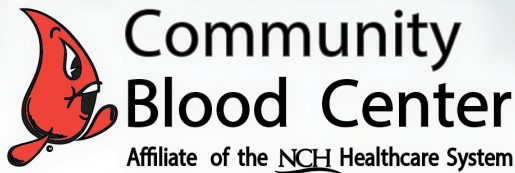


# PLASMA DONATIONS

FROM RECOVERED COVID-19 PATIENTS



## COVID-19 CONVALESCENT PLASMA PROGRAM

Convalescent Plasma is an investigative treatment facilitated by the US Food & Drug Administration (FDA) for use in patients whose infections are serious or immediately life-threatening. Plasma donated by a qualified candidate who has fully recovered from COVID-19 is transfused to a COVID-19 patient. The hope is that the antibodies in the donated plasma can help attack the virus and boost the patient's own immune system.

### People who may qualify to donate convalescent plasma:

- Must have had a prior diagnosis of COVID-19 (from a documented positive lab test).
- Must be fully recovered and symptom free of COVID-19 for at least 14 days prior to your plasma donation and bring a hard copy of a negative follow-up lab test **OR** be fully recovered and symptom free for 28 days prior to plasma donation if you did **NOT** have a follow-up negative test.
- Must be in good health and feeling well.
- Must meet specific laboratory criteria.
